PURPOSE

The Disabled Students' Officer will be a key link between disabled students, the SU and the uni. You'll help us get a better understanding of their student experience at Herts, enabling us to make uni more accessible and supportive. Your work will go a long way in helping students love life at Herts!

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- You'll be the lead student representative for disabled students at the uni, gathering their feedback and raising it with staff members to drive necessary change
- You'll work closely with other student leaders, working together to collate and elevate student views
- Students with disabilities will want to raise their feedback and ideas with you directly, so you'll be expected to make yourself available to hear from them
- As an elected student leader, you'll be held accountable at things like Student Council and other forums, where you'll have to provide updates for the benefit of students
- You'll be involved in a number of SU & University committees, where you'll have to provide updates for the benefit of staff members
- You'll be an ambassador of the SU, encouraging students to engage with us and maximise the opportunities available to them
- You'll get to support us and the uni at big events, from Freshers Week through to the Students' Union Awards
- You'll be expected to report at our Board of Trustees
