- You'll advocate on behalf of students whose experiences you may not share
- You'll be held accountable at things like Student Council and other forums, where you'll have to provide updates for the benefit of students
- As a lead student representative, you'll be asked to provide updates at SU & University committees for the benefit of staff members
- You'll work with the SU & University's marketing teams to promote yourself and your work
- You'll be an ambassador of the SU, encouraging students to engage with us and maximise the opportunities available to them
- You'll get to support us and the uni at flagship events like Open Days, Freshers, Students' Union Awards, graduation ceremonies and more
- You'll be a Student Governor for the University's Board of Governors
